



Plasson Fire Safety Policy

This is the Fire Safety Policy Statement of Plasson UK Ltd

It is the Policy of Plasson UK to prevent the outbreak of fire on our premises and to put in place measures to protect our staff, visitors and other stakeholders in the event of a fire.

Our Technical and Quality Manager has overall responsibility for putting this Policy into effect, although all of our staff have responsibilities for delivering fire safety.

Our statement of general policy is:

- Arranging for a competent fire safety risk assessor to conduct a risk assessment of the premises and review that assessment periodically.
- Implementing the recommended fire safety measures arising from the assessment.
- Ensuring that all exits and emergency routes are kept clear at all times. These routes will be properly signed, adequately lit and fitted with the relevant standard of fire doors.
- Ensuring that the premises have appropriate fire-fighting equipment, detectors, alarms and emergency lighting.
- Writing and circulating fire safety arrangements incorporating responsibilities for fire safety matters.
- Ensuring that building alterations and other contract works are properly managed to minimise the fire risk and avoid damage to structural fire protection.
- Ensuring that all staff are provided with appropriate information and instruction regarding the fire prevention and the emergency procedures, including instruction in order for them to carry out their role.
- Keeping staff informed of any changes that are made to our fire safety procedures.
- Ensuring that all visitors to our premises are briefed on the evacuation procedure and supervised by a member of staff at all times.
- Undertaking ongoing monitoring of the fire safety arrangements including carrying out periodic inspections of the premises to look for fire hazards and to check that fire safety precautions are effectively implemented.
