Our Supply Chain

Our products are predominantly sourced from our parent company Plasson Ltd, with only a minimal number of third party suppliers providing goods and services to support the business.

Processes for eliminating slavery and human trafficking

As part of Plasson's initiative to identify and mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking, where possible:-

Our statement of general policy is:

- We will only use suppliers with whom we have built long standing relationships with and have made clear our expectations of business behaviour.
- We will ensure by audit that significant suppliers have suitable anti-slavery and human trafficking policies and processes.
- Potential new suppliers will be vetted to ensure compliance with this policy.
- We have in place systems to encourage the reporting of concerns and the protection of whistle blowers.
- We have provided training to relevant staff members to recognise the signs of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chain.
- We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. We expect all those in our supply chain and contractors comply with our values.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our group's slavery and human trafficking statement for the current financial year.
